## 2012 CURBSIDE COLLECTIONS

This is the 2012 calendar for the Park Ridge residential curbside solid waste and recycling collections. Please keep this schedule handy throughout the year as a ready reference.

Kindly refer to the legend by the monthly calendars for an explanation of the abbreviations used. The Borough is divided into two collection zones. Zone A is the east side of Park Ridge including Pascack Road. Zone B includes all streets west of Pascack Road. The designation A/B means the entire Borough is scheduled for pickup on that date. **To evenly distribute the days with no garbage collections due to holidays, we have scheduled two dates when the west side (Zone B) will have garbage pickup instead of the east (Jan 17, Sept 4).**

Please be advised that household solid waste and recycling should be placed at the curb no later than 6:30AM on the scheduled day of pickup to ensure that your home is not missed.

**Residents may leave up to two large bulk waste items out for disposal by the curb on any of your designated garbage collection days.** Each item cannot weigh more than 100 lbs and should be waste materials only (e.g. furniture, rugs, mattresses, etc). If you have more than two large items, items weighing over 100 lbs, or you are disposing of metal items that can be recycled as scrap metal (e.g. appliances) you should call the Borough Hall to set up an appointment for a large item trash (TR) pickup. These collections are scheduled every other Monday except during leaf collection season – mid-October to mid-December, by the Borough's Road De-

partment, *by appointment only.*

In addition to the curbside collections, the Borough operates a full service Recycling Center-Compactor (R/C) which is open on Wednesdays from 9 AM to 3 PM and Saturdays from 9 AM to 12 PM. It is available for residents only, and you must have a hanging tag permit attached to your rear view mirror to enter the facility. See the attached insert for items that are accepted at the Recycling Center. The R/C is located at the end of Sulak Lane (off of Pascack Road between the Lukoil gas station and the Pascack Reformed Church). There is also a trash compactor located at the facility for items not disposable through the curbside garbage collections.

Branches (BR) are also collected by the Borough's Road Department, *by appointment only* between April and September. Branches, twigs, and other yard waste can also be brought to the R/C. During leaf pickup, please do not place branches with leaves as neither will be removed.

**You must call 201-573-1800 by 1 P.M. on the Friday prior to the Monday collection date to be put on the Branch (BR) or Large Item (TR) pickup list.**

Grass (GR) is collected curbside weekly by the Borough's contracted collection company from April 2 to October 9 and may also be brought to the Recycling Center throughout the year.

# How Park Ridge RECYCLES



## SAVE THIS FLYER FOR FUTURE REFERENCE

Recycling saves money and helps our community and the world by making it more efficient to reuse existing products. For example, there are inexpensive carpets that are made from recycled plastic bottles and jars. And glass bottles and jars can be repurposed into surfacing materials for roadways. In Park Ridge we separate different materials by categories and recycle them by placing them at the curb or by taking them to our community recycling center off Sulak Lane. Here are items that we recycle:

### COMINGLED ITEMS



- All plastic jars, bottles and other items with the triangle symbol numbers 1 thru 7
- Glass jars and bottles (all colors)
- Aluminum, steel and tin cans and food containers (including steel aerosol cans)

**Notes:** Comingled items should be rinsed and free of food or oil. Plastic bags should be recycled at any of our area's supermarkets (A&P, Kings, Shop-Rite, Stop & Shop).

### PAPER ITEMS

- Includes newspapers, magazines, junk mail, telephone books, paperback books, school and office paper and paper shopping bags
- All cardboard including corrugated

**Note:** Paper and cardboard can be mixed at the curb, but in order to maximize efficiency they are handled separately at the recycling center. They should not be bundled in plastic bags.

### ADDITIONAL ITEMS

Grass, branches, metal, concrete, motor oil, tires, car batteries, minor construction debris, electronics and used clothing are to be disposed of at the center, although grass in containers is also picked up seasonally at curbside. Rechargeable batteries are also recycled at the center but ordinary household/flashlight batteries should be disposed of in your regular trash. Branch and large item curbside pick-ups may be arranged during much of the year by calling the borough office at (201) 573-1800. Household hazardous waste is handled through Bergen County Utilities Authority events. Go to [bcua.org](http://bcua.org) for details and dates.

Materials should be in original containers and labeled.

- Batteries - vehicle & rechargeable only
- Blacktop Sealers
- Bug Spray
- Disinfectants
- Drain Cleaners
- Fertilizer
- Fire Extinguishers
- Fluorescent Light Bulbs
- Gasoline
- Glue
- Herbicides
- Insecticides
- Kerosene
- Lighter Fluid
- Mercury Switches
- Oil Filters (Used)
- Paints & Varnishes-All Types
- Pesticides
- Photographic Chemicals
- Propane Gas Cylinders (1 lb. and 20 lb. only)
- Solvents & Thinners
- Thermostats/Thermometers
- Used Motor Oil

## Unacceptable Materials for HHW Collections

- Alkaline batteries (AA, AAA, C, D, 9V) dispose in normal trash
- Unlabeled waste or containers with unknown contents
- Regulated medical waste, radioactive materials, and explosives
- Containers larger than five (5) gallons
- Compressed cylinders (oxygen or acetylene)
- Pressure-treated lumber or railroad ties
- Computers, electronics, and tires are NOT accepted at HHW collections.

### Directions to Collection Sites

#### Directions to BERGEN COMMUNITY COLLEGE: 4/15/12, 6/10/12, 10/14/12

##### *From the North (via Route 17)*

Turn right off Route 17 South onto Ridgewood Avenue (West) to Paramus Road. Turn left onto Paramus Road and continue approximately two miles to college; proceed around jug handle to main entrance.

##### *From the East*

Take Route 4 West to Paramus Road (Paramus Road is  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile past Route 17 intersection.) Turn right onto Paramus Road and proceed north approximately two miles to Bergen Community College entrance on right.

##### *From the South (via Route 17)*

Take Route 17 North to Century Road exit, second exit to the right, proceed around cloverleaf over Route 17 onto Century Road (West). Continue to Paramus Road and turn right onto Paramus Road to college entrance on right.

##### *From the West*

Take Route 4 East to Paramus Road (exit under overpass). Turn right onto Paramus Road and proceed north for approximately two miles to college entrance on right.

#### Directions to BERGEN COUNTY UTILITIES AUTHORITY: 3/10/12, 7/21/12

##### *Traveling Route 17 North*

Exit at Moonachie/Wood-Ridge exit. Make right at light onto Moonachie Ave. Pass Teterboro Airport (on your left) and continue going straight until road ends into BCUA facilities.

##### *Traveling Route 17 South*

Exit at Moonachie/Wood-Ridge exit. (Exit is by The Fiesta.) Make left at light onto Moonachie Avenue. Pass Teterboro Airport (on your left) and continue going straight until road ends into BCUA facilities.
